General Layout and Accommodations

Indeed "Aventyr" has a very accommodating layout that is unique to her size. Note she features four cabins two of which are full beam!

Large aft covered California deck with custom Corian table. Sliding doors open to main salon with large settees and a hi/lo Smart TV. Galley is centered in between salon and lower helm area. Large windows provide for lots of natural light.

The Master stateroom is located amidships tacking full advantage of the widest part of the beam of the vessel. She features an Island bed arrangement with Ornate Birdseye maple cabinetry. Cleverly designed and separated from cabin the walk in head is one step up. In it features a split and separate shower stall and bath tub to truly spoil guests.

Up in the bow is another Guest stateroom with Island bed walk around and abundant storage. Guest stateroom head with large shower stall.

Forward again to starboard is another stateroom with upper and lower berth bunk room with its own ensuite head. There is one additional full beam stateroom also located aft as well. Access is from the aft starboard corner of the salon and down a few steps. It could easily double as another master stateroom. It benefits from being aft and isolated from the other cabins in the vessel. It also has its own door aft to access the swim platform area which is great for ventilation or allowing more natural light to stateroom. Again a walk around berth with abundant storage.

Galley

The galley is both the focal & social point of the salon. It is right in the middle of the vessel so meal preparation becomes easier. The galley features new appliances in 2020 and include the following:
