Vessel Layout

Boarding R POD is made easy via her upgraded teak swim platform with S/S safety rails. Enter through the transom via a swing inward transom door on into the spacious cockpit with upgraded teak sole. The cockpit is protected by a new canvas enclosure.

Once inside the salon you'll be greeted by a new leather sofa to port fronted by a highly customized hi/low table that folds open for dining. Further forward is the pass through area that has been converted to book storage. Across to starboard are two comfortable custom swivel chairs with storage flanked by a custom built table. Continuing forward is a handsome built-in cabinet that contains a pop up TV, dry bar and assorted entertainment equipment.

The salon is tastefully decorated. The American cherry joinery with it's timeless satin finish is impeccable. Large, oversized salon windows allow outstanding visibility whether underway or at rest in a quiet cove.

Continuing forward and up two steps is the raised pilothouse featuring a U-shaped galley to port, a comfortable dinette to starboard and the center lined helm station with it's excellent visibility all the way forward. Side deck access is available on both the port and starboard sides making line handling and fender deployment a breeze.

The lower deck with it's three staterooms and two heads are accessed on the starboard side of the pilothouse via a curved stairway. The master stateroom being aft, full beam with it's private ensuite head. Forward and to port is the guest cabin with twin upper and lower berths followed by the VIP Cabin which is so spacious it rivals the size of most master cabins. Both guest cabins share the starboard side head off the companionway.

The flybridge and boat deck can be accessed by the curved stairway off the pilothouse or the built-in FRP steps in the cockpit.

Salon

Located aft of the pilothouse down two steps..

Warm, inviting, comfortable, tasteful, open and airy are words that come to mind when describing this spacious retreat. Timeless satin finished American cherry joinery. Warm designer fabrics. Custom built furniture you have to see to believe. Large windows that provide excellent sight lines whether at rest in a cozy cove or underway.
